




Christmas Party: Diane Stiller

Education – Diane Stiller

Everyone really enjoyed Debra Welty's 2-day workshop. We did a single and a double acrylic pour and made necklaces and earrings from the drippings. We used stencils and various textured mediums and paints. Both Debra and Sheri Redd brought their stencils so there were quite a number to choose from and combine. We painted the coneflower on a canvas bag using Deco Arts Styling paint which was specifically made to paint on canvas and leather. If anyone is interested in purchasing more of the Liberty canvas bags that we used in class, Sheri purchased them from NYFifth.com. Debra suggested purchasing them from OneStopInc.com. The bags come in colors other than white. The glue that Sheri used for the jewelry is called Glaze & Glue from craftfantastic.com.

A Big Thank You to Sheri Redd who worked with Debra Welty on selecting the projects and for bringing all of the supplies that were used. I also noticed that Debra uses a dish towel just like Beth Wagner for absorbing the water from her brush instead of paper towels. Such a coincidence that we would have two instructors who do this.





Sheri Redd used this for the jewelry.



Transfer Cloth that was demonstrated by Beth Wagner and mentioned by Diane Stiller at the Cookie Painting. This is sold by Diane Bunker.

I have laid a layer of the cloth on the top right corner so you can see how sheer it is. Great to use to transfer patterns onto curved or round surfaces.


February SATURDAY Meeting Activity

We look forward to you signing up for the February projects and sharing this project with you. Dawn and Rondi




Book of the Month

Prudy Vannier's fruit workshop was a fun class where everyone could work at their own pace refining their skills on how to paint different fruit and creating step-by-step workbooks for themselves. Thanks Prudy for a wonderful workshop!



Sam Farah taught her original design of this snowman project which included using quik wood for the nose and arms. Sam generously painted a small snowman face as a gift for everyone in class and provided a raffle prize won by Louise Brown. We were able to complete the project and even leave early. The calligraphy lesson alone for the lettering on the back was worth attending this class. Sam provided calligraphy practice sheets which can be used over and over again. And of course, what's a Sam Farah project without glitter!!



Make Your Own "Quik Wood" Recipe

I attended the Oklahoma Painting Palooza this year and had a class with Bobbie Takashima using quik wood to do some sculpting. She happened to mention that she used to make her own "quik wood". You have to make it in small batches as it hardens quickly. I thought some of you might be adventurous enough to try to make your own. Here's the recipe.

On a paper plate, place 1 tablespoon of Durham's water putty powder and make a well in it. Fill the well with wood glue (the yellow kind; she didn't give a measurement). Add ½ tablespoon of water and just a few drops of vinegar; then mix.



What a relaxing day we spent painting our angels all different colors and fabrics! Since there was no instructor, everyone painted at their own pace. It was our final class of the year. Members asked to have similar classes next year where they can socialize more and paint at leisure.
